- ... an **interregional cooperation** programme covering 27 EU-MS + NO and CH
- ... about "learning by sharing"
- ... aiming at **improving local and regional development practices** and **policies** by accessing the experience of others in Europe facing similar issues
- ... mainly dedicated to **local and regional authorities** & bodies governed by public law
- ... providing a total of 302 MEUR ERDF funding




Programme priorities



2 thematic priorities:

- Innovation & the knowledge economy
- Environment & risk prevention
- 3 (out of 4) calls already closed with:
 - 122 running projects
 - 1334 partners involved

Approved projects by sub-theme (1-3 Call)




- 19 projects (15%) address the sub-theme Energy and Sustainable Transport
- 222 partners involved in INTERREG IVC projects working on energy issues

MORE4NRG

- 13 partners from 8 different countries
- Total budget: EUR 1,326,559 (36 months)
- Objective: to improve regional strategies for renewables and energy efficiency and to develop an integrated monitoring tool for measuring the effects of regional energy strategies
- Results so far in Gabrovo Region (BG) further to a peer review by Västernorrland Region (SE)
 - Good practice transferred: appointment of an energy manager within the regional administration
 - Regional policy improved: modification of the Gabrovo Regional Development Strategy by the inclusion of a measure on 'Energy efficiency and Renewables'
